# Jessop Primary Pre-School

Our pre-school has space for 16 two year olds. A majority of our places are for children entitled to the governments early learning funding of 15 hours per week and we have a limited amount of paid places.

Our pre-school runs from 8:45am until 11:45am, Monday to Friday, term time only. If your child is eligible and has been accepted for the two year funding, you would like more information or to put your name onto our waiting list, please call Jessop Children's Centre on 0207 737 5164

# Rose Voucher Scheme

Our Children's Centres are part of the Rose Voucher fruit and vegetable scheme in Lambeth. This scheme helps families that are expecting a child or have children under the age of 4 to access more healthy and affordable fresh food from local markets. If you are accessing benefits or you are on a low income you may be eligible to join up to this scheme and collect weekly vouchers to buy fresh fruit and vegetables. For more information or to join the scheme please contact one of the children's centre.

## Free Early Learning for 2 Year Olds

Since September 2014 families who are eligible for free school meals and those in receipt of working tax credit, earning no more than £16,190 annually, can receive a free early learning place with a nursery or childminder for their two year old. Children in receipt of DLA are also eligible.

Eligible families will be able to have a free early learning place for 570 hours per year, starting from the term after a child turns 2 years old.

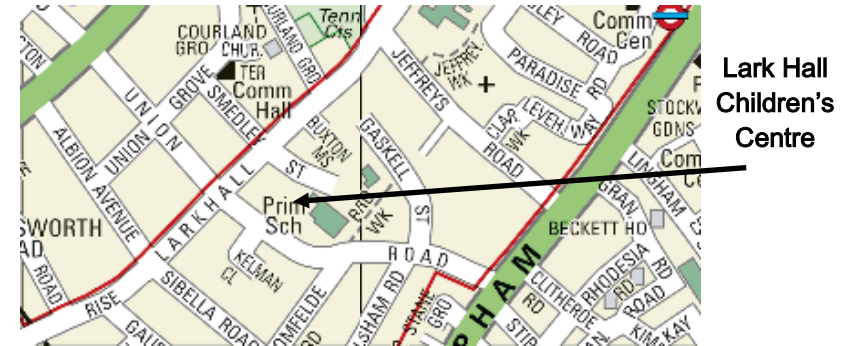

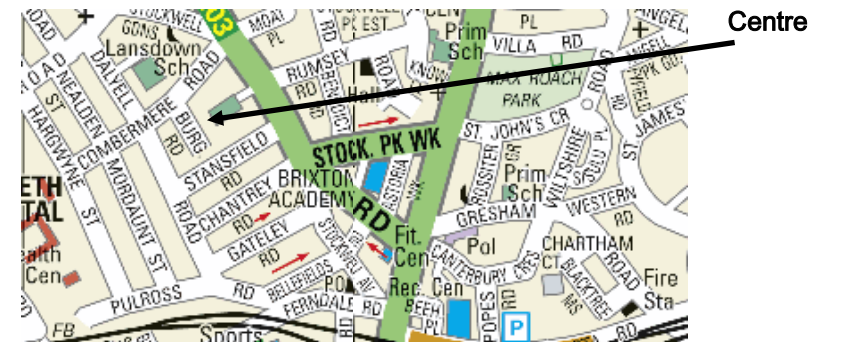
